COVID-19 Vaccines

With the recent pause on the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, we have made a slight adjustment to our plans for the COVID-19 vaccine distribution clinics. We will be offering the Moderna two-dose vaccine at our campuses for the time being. Remember, these vaccines are FREE to all YES Prep staff, students, and families who are 18 years of age or older.

On April 23, we will be holding our first clinics at two of our campuses. If your child is a student at one of these two campuses, our staff will be in touch with you directly with instructions on how to sign up for an appointment. For our remaining campuses, we will be rolling out more clinics in the coming weeks. Your child's campus will be in touch with you as more information becomes available.

Annual Family-School Relationships Survey

To ensure we continue to provide high quality, rigorous learning experiences that meet the needs of our learners and prepare them for college and career, we need your input. This year, we have partnered with Panorama Education to conduct our 2021 annual Family-School Relationships Survey. Panorama safeguards your privacy, keeping your responses confidential. The survey will be a valuable source of information for us as we work to make our schools and district the best they can be.

STAAR Update

STAAR is an important data point for our students, campuses, and district. If you have not yet already, please review the information <u>on this site</u>.

All campuses will be running their regular bus routes on STAAR days. If your student needs to take the bus on their testing day(s), please refer to your campus's most updated routes and stops to find the stop most convenient for your student. The most current routes and stops are posted on your campus website and will be posted through social media. If you need any assistance, please contact the front office of your campus.



Buses will continue to follow all COVID safety procedures. If a bus is full before reaching all stops, a second bus will be dispatched to complete the route, or the original bus will drop off the students on campus and then complete the rest of the route.

AP Summits

This week we shared information with all AP students about registration for upcoming AP Summits. AP summits are important opportunities for students to prepare for their exams which may earn college credits while still in high school! AP Summit dates will be on May 1 and May 8. Students will begin registration for AP Summit today, April 16. This event will be virtual and hosted on Microsoft Teams. Students should register for AP Summits on Eventbrite using the links shared with them in Microsoft Teams.

Elementary End of Year MAP Testing

Students in grades K-2 will be taking their End of Year Reading and Math MAP tests between April 26-May 14. We administer MAP tests to monitor your student's growth throughout the school year. It is an adaptive test on the computer that will help us pinpoint your child's strengths and places where additional supports are needed. Students learn better, and faster, when we have a clear picture of what each student knows and what they're ready to learn next.

To see samples of reading and math questions in English or Spanish, please visit <u>http://practice.mapnwea.org</u>. The username and password is "grow". Students in grades K-1 will take the **Reading K-2** assessment and students in grade 2 will take the **Reading** assessment.

Additional communication on MAP testing will come from your campus – please encourage your student to do their best on these assessments!
